

CITY OF MANSFIELD
MINUTES OF *SPECIAL* PUBLIC MEETING
October 29, 2012

In a *special meeting* called pursuant to the provisions of R.S.: 42.7, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen met on Monday, October 29th, in Mansfield City Hall located at 705 Polk Street. The meeting was called to order at 4:30 p.m. by Mayor McCoy, after which an **Invocation** was offered by Alderman Joseph Hall, Jr. The **Pledge of Allegiance** was led by Alderman Troy N. Terrell. Following the pledge, the roll was called and the following officials were recorded as present: **Present:** Honorable Curtis W. McCoy, G. B. Hall III –District **A**, Troy N. Terrell, - District **B**, Mitchell L. Lewis –District **C**, and Joseph Hall, Jr. –District **D**. **Absent:** None. **Press Present:** None.

The Public Comments Period was opened by Mayor McCoy to hear any public comments from those in attendance with regard to the sole item of new business reflected on the meeting agenda. When no public comments were offered, the **Public Comments Period** was then closed.

This special meeting was called to adopt a Resolution acknowledging the passing of Hon. **Alvin R. Woodley** (Alderman -District E), to appoint a person to fill the vacancy of Alderman Woodley's unexpired term of office, and to call a special election to fill the vacancy that resulted from his passing. The Council acknowledged the passing of Alderman Woodley on **October 10, 2012** and the vacancy caused as a result of his untimely death. Following this acknowledgement, Mayor McCoy recommended appointing **Cynthia T. Cruse** to fill the vacancy in District E until the impending special election on October 19, 2013. The qualifying period prior to this special election is August 14th through August 16th, 2013. After a brief discussion, it was MOTIONED by G. B. HALL III and SECONDED by TROY N. TERRELL to adopt a Resolution to address and satisfy all of the issues first above written. Motion Passed Unanimously. (Full copy of Resolution on file at Mansfield City Hall).

With no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned at 4:33 p.m. by MOTION from JOSEPH HALL, JR. and was SECONDED by MITCHELL L. LEWIS. Motion Passed Unanimously.
